Opening up Education – Why

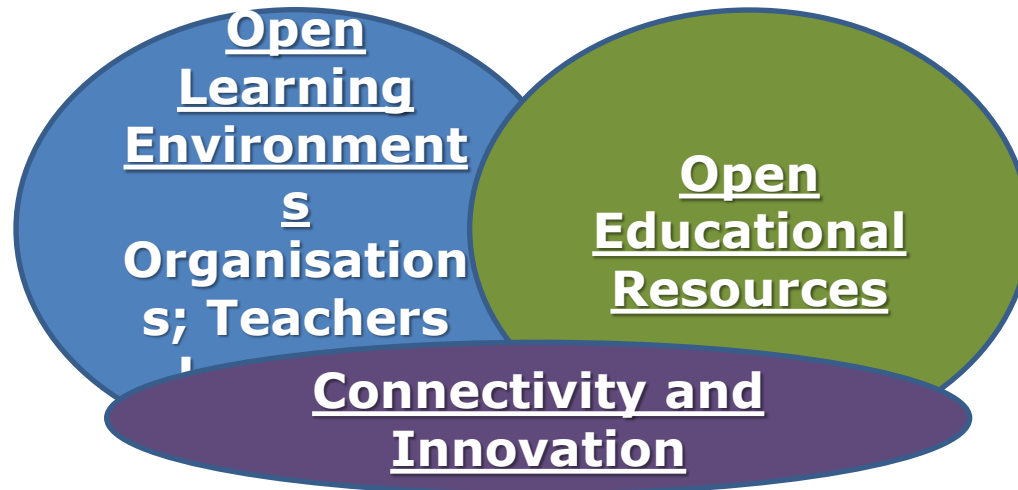
For stimulating high-quality, innovative ways of learning and teaching through new technologies and digital content;

Because EU education is failing to keep pace with the digital society and economy;

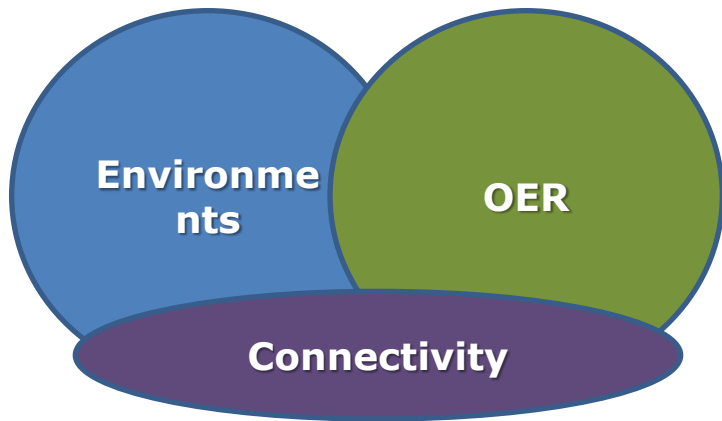
And technology provides the opportunity to increase efficiency and equity in education.

A systemic approach, addressing different axis at the same time:



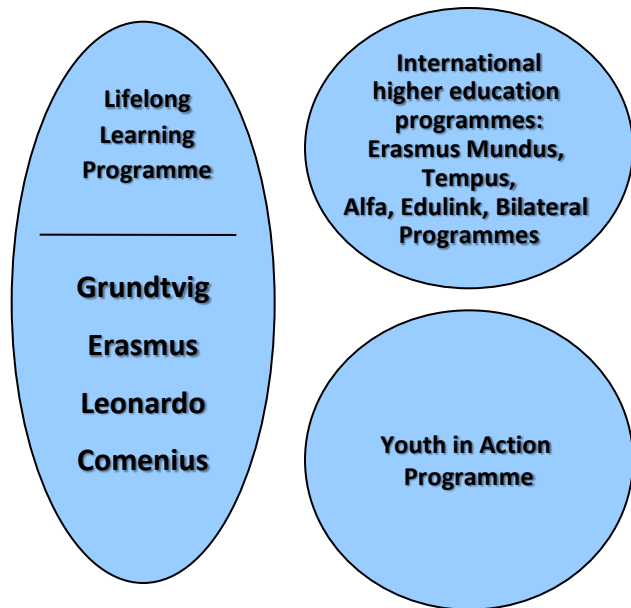

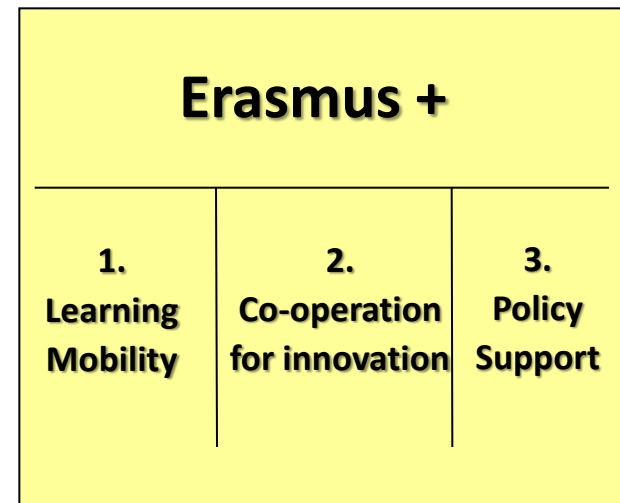
