

The basic project management information

- Information required to manage a project:
 - Scope (deliverable)
 - Work
 - Events (milestones)
 - Team
 - Costs
 - Time
- There are 2 basic information structures to collect all that data:
 - Work Breakdown Structure (WBS)
 - Plan



Work Breakdown Structure




RULES

- Each element (called workpackage) represents an amount of work to be performed
- Each workpackage represents the sum of the work of all its children
- Each workpackage has only one parent (except for the root workpackage)






Example of WBS - 1
