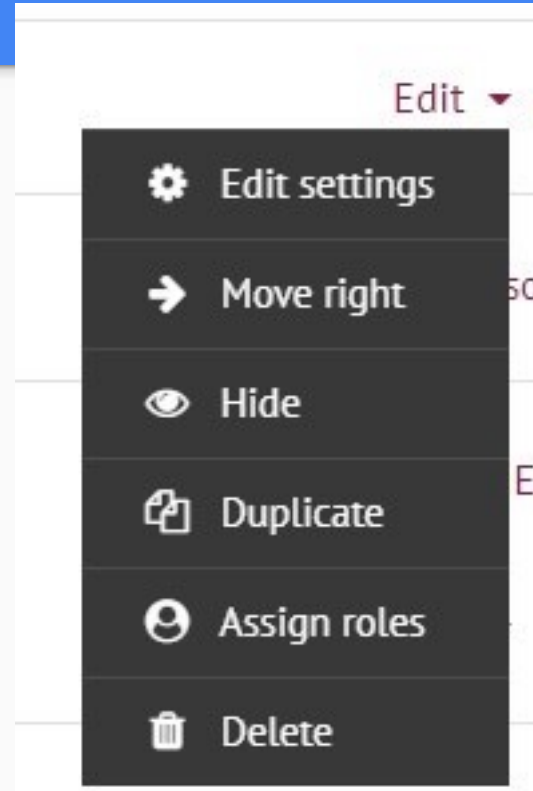


## Criteria-based assessment

- This type of assessment is based on the assessment criteria.
- Before assessing student's work, teacher describes the assessment criteria and sets the maximum possible score for each of the assessment criterion.

## How to design criteria-based assessment in Moodle?

- Go to the course and press "**Edit parameters**" next to the activity in which you want to set criteria-based assessment.



## How to design criteria-based assessment in Moodle?

- In the section **“Grades”**, in the Grading method section, select **“Marking guide”**
- Then, press **“Save and Display”**

## How to design criteria-based assessment in Moodle?

- Enter the name of the form.

## How to design criteria-based assessment in Moodle?

- Fill in the parts of the assessment criteria.
- It is necessary to fill in **the name and the highest score** (the highest score indicates how many points the learner can get for a specific criterion, the sum of the points of all the criteria must be equal to the final possible number of points, usually it is 10 points).
- To complete the descriptions, click on the corresponding box.
- To add a new criterion, click "**+ Add criterion**".

## How to design criteria-based assessment in Moodle?

- When adding criteria, you can choose whether to display their descriptions and scores to learners. These points are marked automatically, without changing anything, the learner will see the criteria and their values.

### Marking guide options

- Show guide definition to students
- Show marks per criterion to students

- After preparing the evaluation criteria, they should be saved.
- 1 - save and use in subject assessment
- 2 - Save as draft

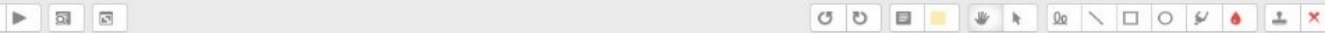
## How to design criteria-based assessment in Moodle?

- After selecting “**Save**” the assessment form and use the assessment criteria, the **assessment criteria** are **ready for use and** are **visible** in the assessment activity.
